

GUIDANCE FOR GROCERY STORES

Coronavirus (COVID-19)



Wash your hands

Ensure soap is always supplied in employee restrooms, and throughout store departments. Especially in places where employees may be in close contact.

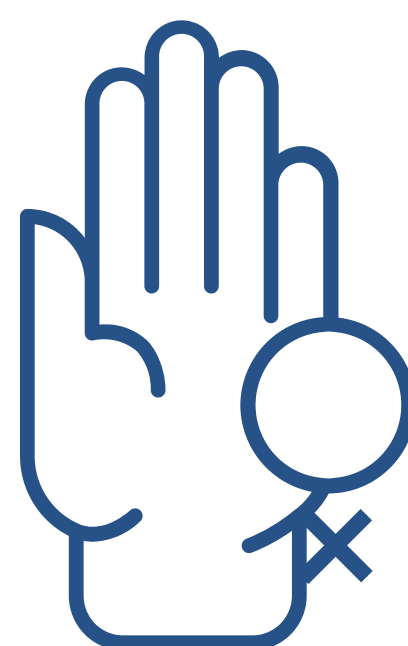


Clean and disinfect surfaces and objects that people frequently touch (carts, pin pads, etc). Consider periodic closures for restocking and cleaning.

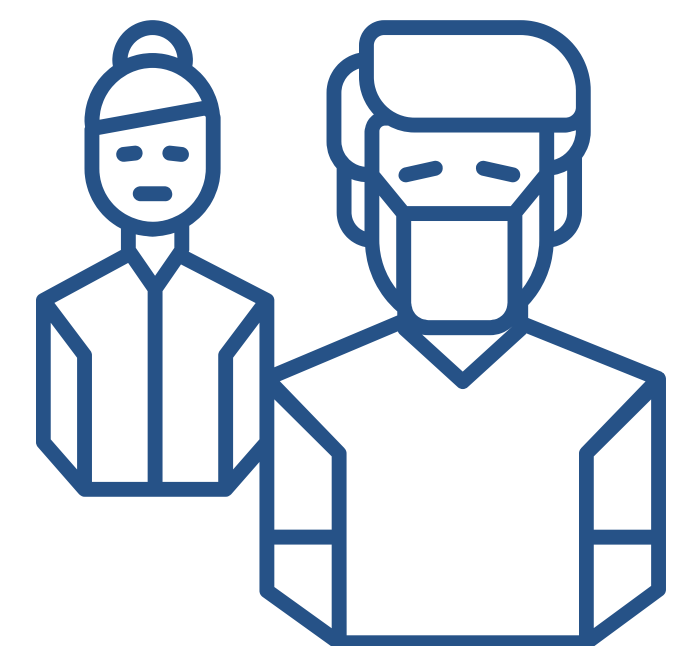


Altered Business Hours

Set designated time periods for higher-risk individuals to shop (early morning, after closing to clean, etc.). Potentially establish longer store hours to disperse traffic.



Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands. Use hand sanitizer at checkout stands and door entrances (if possible).



Avoid close contact

Establish controls to ensure crowds are in compliance. Keep 6 foot distances during checkout. Assign employees with higher health-risks to tasks with the lowest exposure risks.



Alternative Options expand into grocery delivery services (if possible). Have orders called in for pickup at designated times, and deliver orders to cars.
