2017 Proposed Budget

Executive Statement

We are pleased to present the 2017 preliminary budget for NCHD. The proposed budget presented this year totals \$3,594,130.36. County contributions account for 19.42% and State Per Capita accounts for 6.23%. Fees, donations and miscellaneous revenue are expected to be 9.36% and Medicaid/Private Insurance is estimated at 2.93% of the budget. Grant and contracts make up the majority of our budget at 62.06%.

The budget includes a 3% cost of living increase for the staff to help offset the large increases we have seen in health insurance over the last several years. We are happy to report that only a 3.5% increase in health insurance premiums is expected to occur in 2017.

The agency currently has 3.87 months in reserves totaling 1,077,901.35. This is in line with the Board of Health approved range of 3 to 6 months.

We are excited to announce that we are moving forward with the purchase of a new building in Fort Morgan as approved by the Board of Health. According to our purchase plan and the sale of our current building, NCHD will continue to operate with 3.50 months of reserves funds.

Thank you for your continued support! Your county contributions continue to make rural public health thrive in northeast Colorado and we take great pleasure in working with you!


